


Step 3:

Complete all of our Pre-Qualifying Questions to determine exactly what scholarship criteria you meet.

Step 4:

Start filling out your online application. You don't have to finish it all at once. You can save your work and come back anytime to work on it before the scholarship deadline. Some scholarships will require you to write an essay, get letters of recommendation or provide copies of your transcripts. Your application will not be considered complete until we have all of the information we need.

Tip 1:

Fill out a FAFSA. If you plan to apply for any kind of financial aid, you need to complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Tip 2:

If you have questions about financial aid, ask your guidance counselor or someone in the financial aid office at one of our local colleges.

Tip 3:

KnowHow2Go offers many resources and tips for the entire college going process. Use these resources! Information can be found at www.sccresa.org

Tip 4:

Start looking early for scholarships – It is never too early to look because it may influence how a student is involved and will make you more aware of the resources that are available.

Tip 5:

Don't discount local scholarships. A \$100 scholarship is still \$100 less that you need to pay back or it could help offset some additional expenses, like books.
